


Detained (2024)

Description

Felipe Mucci's direction in <u>it</u> is masterful, creating a claustrophobic and tense atmosphere that keeps the audience on edge. Laz Alonso and Moon Bloodgood add depth to the film with their roles as detectives, bringing a mix of aggression and empathy that heightens the tension. Justin H. Min, as Isaac Barsi, and Silas Weir Mitchell further enrich the ensemble with their nuanced performances.

Storyline and Writing


- The film is heavily inspired by "The Usual Suspects," featuring a mysterious villain and numerous twists and turns that keep the audience guessing 1.
