






A Soulful Journey Through Music and Self-Discovery



She performs regularly at a hotel bar, but her heartfelt songs are drowned out by the chatter of inattentive patrons more interested in their phones

At home, the film faces the additional burden of caring for her sick mother, who dismisses her dreams with the harsh reality of being "a 40-year-old troubadour." A chance encounter with a flyer for a South Dakota biker rally/music festival propels into a new chapter of her life. There, she meets Casey, a Scottish musician played by Thomas Doherty who has resigned himself to a life in sales, believing his best musical days are behind him. Their connection ignites a slow-burning romance, intertwined with their shared love for music (The New York Times).











Layne delivers a powerful performance as Dandelion, capturing the character's vulnerability and determination. Dandelion's journey is one of self-discovery as she navigates the challenges of pursuing her passion in a world that often seems indifferent to her talent. Her interactions with Casey and his friends provide a sense of community and recognition that she has longed for, highlighting the importance of finding one's tribe (Flickering Myth).

Doherty's portrayal of Casey is equally compelling. He embodies the brooding, passionate musician who has given up on his dreams yet finds a renewed sense of purpose through his relationship with Dandelion. Riegel's direction is masterful, creating a film that feels both intimate and expansive. The cinematography captures the beauty of the South Dakota landscape, providing a stunning backdrop for Dandelion's journey. The use of extreme close-ups during musical performances emphasizes the emotional connection between the characters and their art

While the film excels in its character development and thematic depth, it occasionally falters in its pacing. The film's focus on Dandelion's interiority is a strength, but there are moments where she feels sidelined in her own story. The sprint to the conclusion, in particular, feels rushed and detracts from the careful buildup of the first two acts

Despite these shortcomings, it is a warm and meditative film that captures the fleeting, volatile nature of love and artistic passion. It is a testament to the power of music and the human spirit, leaving a lasting impression on its audience.
