Marketed as a "**fresh, funny, and original**" **production**, "Naked Acts" surprises viewers by not becoming comedic until 35 minutes in. The producer's frustration with his novice cast provides a

humorous moment, especially during a silent acting scene soundtracked to anarchic orchestra music.

The **4K restoration** highlights the luminous skin of the all-Black cast beautifully. The alarming red wig worn by Cicely contrasts perfectly with the neighboring blue-light scenes, creating an evocative, eye-catching effect that imbues Cicely with the fiercely independent character she displays throughout much of the film. This effect is furthered by the keen sense of **lighting and fashion**.

The pursuit of safety in the film is tangible. Cicely's cries for her father, whom she associates with safety, juxtapose with the danger she felt around her mother's lover. This pulls the audience through her metamorphosis. Throughout the film, the camera focuses on Cicely's insular nature with close-up shots. As she opens up, she becomes comfortable with naked self-portraiture. This visual journey sees the camera quietly studying and encouraging her rather than leering.

The film's language is calm and cool. Conversations between Cicely and her ex-boyfriend Joel, played by Ron Cephas Jones, feel like everyday exchanges between lovers. Joel's reassurance, "You're new and improved, just gotta look in the mirror," during an intimate couch scene, showcases the timelessness of their flirtation. While Cicely's initial narration is confusing and indecisive, these moments of clarity make the film's conclusion a **tear-jerker**.
