A Hilarious Whodunit with Heart

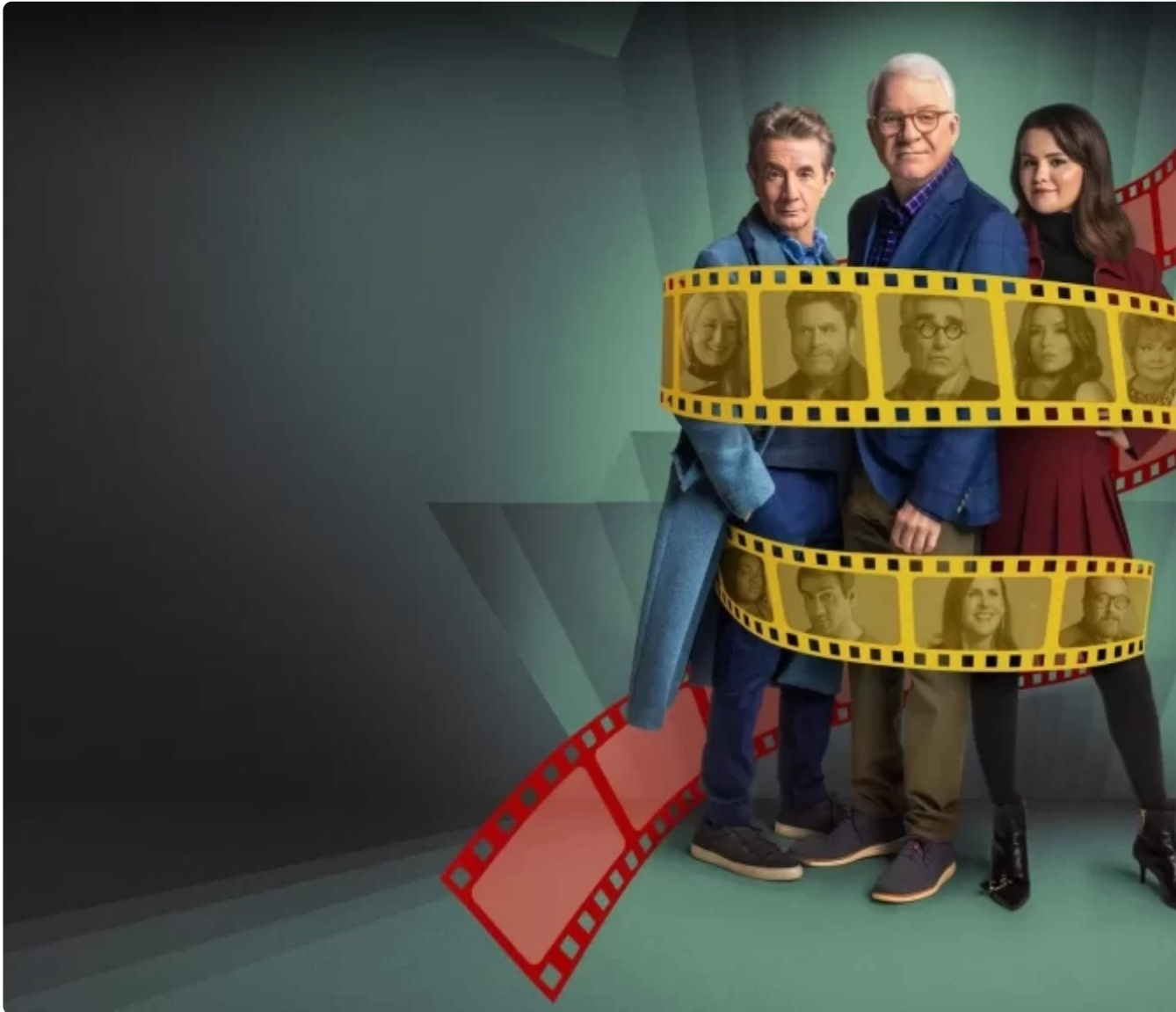
